The Earl Martin Memorial Scholarship  
*High School Student Application*

The SMACNA Chapters of Central Indiana, Lafayette and Fort Wayne Scholarship are open to high school students seeking to further their education by attending an accredited four-year university or college. The applicant may pursue any course of study; however, special consideration will be given to those fields relating to the sheet metal industry. Applicants must reside in the geographical area covered by the Central Indiana, Lafayette, or Fort Wayne SMACNA chapters. Applicants must be a dependent of a SMWIA Local #20 member, a dependent of an officer or principal of a SMACNA member firm, or otherwise directly related to the sheet metal industry, as determined by the board of directors. **The scholarship is open to students entering their first year of college.** Students may reapply each year, however; after receiving two Earl Martin Memorial Scholarships the student becomes ineligible for a third award. Scholarship awards will range from \$500- \$2,000 per academic year. Selection will be based upon the number of qualified applicants in the areas of educational goals, academic achievement, leadership, extra-curricular activities, and attitude. ***Applications must be submitted by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year*** to: Sheet Metal Contractors Association, 1 N.
